- Senior year is one that we have looked forward to for a long time. This is not a time to rest and take easy classes - Colleges and Employers do NOT want to see this! You want to make the most of your senior year!
- Taking the ACT and hitting your benchmarks is an important part of opening the door to senior privileges. **Be sure that you have attained the benchmark or higher in English (18), Math (19), and Reading (20).** We will not be offering another "free" ACT at Eastern. You will have to register for a National ACT Test Date

Take the ACT on March 12th SERIOUSLY! You will save yourself so much heartache if you are able to hit your benchmarks the first time!

- Senior year brings just a few required classes - the rest of your day will be filled with electives - **CHOOSE THEM WISELY!**
SENIOR ENGLISH (English 4, AP Literature, AP Composition (limited seats))
SENIOR MATH (Algebra 3, Pre Cal, Calculus, Statistics, AP Calculus, AP Statistics)
PATHWAY COURSE (completing the sequence = cord at graduation)
GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (PE/HEALTH, Humanities, etc.)
NOTE! Consider taking the third/fourth year of world language, science or social studies electives! Many students who have graduated before you have entered college with one or two semesters of college credit under their belt!
- **DUAL CREDIT Classes!** Students can take dual credit classes in the area of College Algebra (22 math), Spanish, Humanities (through the fourth year of Chorus & Guitar) and Business. **Students will have to attain specific ACT scores to be considered for the dual credit class!** Students are also eligible for the Kentucky Dual Credit Scholarship and the Kentucky Work Ready Scholarship.
- If you have a 2.5 grade point average (or higher) **AND hit your benchmarks on the ACT** you will have a few **SENIOR PRIVILEGES** to look forward to:
 - **Senior Aide** (2.5 g.p.a) - NO CREDIT AWARDED
Use 6500001 as the course number
 - **Peer Tutor** (for Ms. Bryar & Mr. White) (3.0 g.p.a.) - $\frac{1}{2}$ credit awarded for each semester
Use 69038011 as the course number

- **Eagle Enrichment Tutor** (includes tutoring underclassmen) (3.0 g.p.a.) - $\frac{1}{2}$ credit awarded for each semester.
Use **49038011** as the course number
- **Peer Mediator** (more details will be coming on this at a later time)

You can be an Aide AND a Peer Tutor OR an Eagle Enrichment Tutor =)

You cannot be an Eagle Enrichment Tutor AND a Peer Tutor =|

You cannot be an Aide AND a Peer Tutor AND and Eagle Enrichment Tutor =(
